



Structuring the Block/Period for Distance Learning

The purpose of this document is to support teachers with how to structure their 65-minute block (B) or 40-minute period (P) and support all students with distance learning. The time frames are fluid, and the ideas listed here are not exhaustive.

Synchronous Instruction I Do, We Do B: 35-45 minutes P: 20-25 minutes	Live instruction Interactive mini-lessons, initial instruction, investigations, discussions Bellwork/warm-up SEL activity Take attendance Make connections with students Revisit previously taught concepts	Utilize Effective Instruction Framework Model by sharing screen Maximize interactions using student practice to check for understanding Explain next activity (model, where to find when due, small-group instruction, etc)

Student:


- Desires to learn at home

- Communicates and checks in regularly (suggested at least once a week if not more) with teachers and Aeries Portal regarding their child's learning
- Ensures their child will participate in synchronous lessons and complete assigned work per class requirement
- Provides a safe, supportive, and organized learning environment for child
